# **Eating and Drinking**

There are many fine restaurants and cafes in Hobart and the surrounds. Here is a small selection of our picks.

If you can't decide where to go there are a few restaurant districts that you can head to and just walk along the street until you find something that you like. The main areas are Elizabeth Street in North Hobart, The Salamanca area, around Hampden Road, Battery Point and Sandy Bay village area.
